Subject: CURFEW EXEMPTION COVID-19

With the imminent celebration of Easter upon us, and understanding the immense joy that you bring to the children of these islands, I am pleased to inform you that your services have been deemed essential, per Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulation 2020.

While carrying out your official duties, **the Easter Bunny** is exempt from movement restrictions **during the hard curfew to deliver essential cargo such as baskets, chocolate, candy and other treats, and to facilitate the hiding of eggs.** This is pursuant to section 49(1) of the Police Law (2014 Revision) to specifically combat the COVID-19 pandemic threat.

Members of law enforcement have assured me that they will cooperate with your essential duties without requesting your government-issued ID. On behalf of the Competent Authority, we do wish you every success with your essential work in these difficult and unprecedented times – and a very happy Easter!
