**Subject: CURFEW EXEMPTION COVID-19**

Amidst concern recently voiced among the children of these Cayman Islands, I am writing to inform you that you have been granted the status of an **essential service provider**, per Public Health (Prevention, Control and Suppression of Covid-19) Regulation 2020.

While carrying out their official or employment related duties, **the Tooth Fairy** is exempt from movement restrictions **during the soft and hard curfew hours to perform loading of essential dental cargo while providing financial and/or other forms of compensation in exchange**. This is pursuant to section 49(1) of the Police Law (2014 Revision) to specifically combat the COVID-19 pandemic threat.

Potential recipients of your generosity must comply with the instructions of parents and guardians for appropriate staging of said dental cargo.

Members of law enforcement have assured me that they will cooperate with your essential duties without requesting your government-issued ID. On behalf of the Competent Authority, we wish you every success with your essential work in these difficult and unprecedented times.
