## RE Construction Work Begins at Cayman Brac

Daggaro has begun the mechanical clearing of our property adjoining the international airport on Cayman Brac, as a precursor to the construction of our aircraft parking apron and hangar. In accordance with Cayman planning approvals, future flight operations will occur from the Charles Kirkconnell International Airport.

“While working to provide significant investment and beneficial services to the Cayman Islands and the Caribbean Basin, Daggaro has tried very hard to balance development with environmental protection,” CEO Myles Newlove stated. He added, “As a result of the feedback we solicited and received from multiple sources, we adjusted our plan where possible. The changes include redesigning our hangar to reduce the footprint. That downsizing reduces the area we need to clear and preserves more of the natural vegetation. We are working hard to be righteous and transparent members of the community and to bring much needed jobs to support Cayman Brac, following the completion of the project.”

In anticipation of this effort, Daggaro worked closely with environmental experts. Various media, social media groups, environmentalists, and individuals had made unsupportable claims about high concentration of Sister Island Rock Iguanas on the property. However, multiple, extensive in-depth and multi-day site surveys by Cayman Islands Department of Environment and its internationally recognized rock iguana experts could only locate one resident female on the property. It has since being safely relocated by DOE for the duration of the clearing activities. Further, Daggaro has worked closely with the Department of the Environment to design procedures to ensure no other iguanas would be harmed during the development activity.

Daggaro is investing over \$12 million (USD) into the property. Daggaro actively participated in the *Employing Cayman Job Fair* in March and follow-up interviews in April to support expanding workforce needs. Tanya Newlove, Vice President for Programmes, also noted, “We are pleased to have participated in recent Career Days on Grand Cayman and Cayman Brac to educate students on STEM [Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math] career opportunities and to engage in STEM activities in Cayman Islands schools.”

Daggaro looks forward to completing this project and providing our services to the region.
