

**Guidelines for Designation as an Institutionally Registered Facility to employ practitioners on the Institutional Registration List**

**Applicants are required to submit the following to the Ministry of Health & Wellness for submission to Cabinet for consideration:**

**1. Number of practitioners to be registered on the Institutional Registration List**

- a. The number of practitioners to be registered should be appropriate to the size of the Institution in order to ensure that there is an appropriate level of supervision.
- b. The gearing ratios must allow for appropriate supervision.

**2. Areas of expertise/specialties**

- a. A doctor who holds expertise in a particular area, and who is placed on the Institutional Registration List will be expected to practice within her/his area of expertise or specialism.
- b. Such a person who has an expertise in their subject matter, would undertake work predominantly (90% of their working hours) within that field.

**3. Jurisdictions from which the practitioners are expected**

- a. The institution from which the degree was earned will be considered in conjunction with the jurisdictions.
- b. Jurisdiction considers the country in which the specialty was earned.
- c. Jurisdiction considers known educational standards in the country from which the practitioners are expected.

**4. Types of services to be offered**

- a. The numbers of available practitioners already available in the healthcare market will be considered.

**5. Any other request for information**

- a. Financial Standing within the Cayman Islands and any other jurisdiction with connection to the company/business;
- b. Stability/Long standing presence in the Cayman Islands;
- c. A minimum number of qualified medical practitioners on the "principal list" ;
- d. Evidence of attaining and maintaining high clinical standards;
- e. Demonstrable record of adhering to and complying with the regulatory environment in the jurisdiction;
- f. A clean bill of health or no adverse report findings from the HPC and/or Councils.
